

COURTROOM DRESS CODE


For all persons seeking entrance into a Circuit Courtroom of the 22nd Judicial Circuit of Alabama the following shall apply.

- All persons must be dressed appropriately for admission.
- Adult males may not wear any of the following
 - Short pants
 - Flip flops
 - Sleeveless shirts
 - Pants worn below the natural waistline
 - Any garment that contains offensive, obscene and/or inappropriate words or pictures
 - Any other clothing deemed inappropriate by the court

- Adult females may not wear any of the following


- Excessively short pants
- Excessively short skirts
- Low cut tops
- Casual flip flops (this does not include dress sandals)
- Any garment that contains offensive, obscene and/or inappropriate words or pictures.
- Any other clothing deemed inappropriate by the court

As to any items of questionable clothing that are not specifically listed above and which the Security Officer is not certain should be excluded, he should inform the person that he cannot be certain because it is not specified on the list but the Judge presiding may not allow them to remain in Court and that the Judge may require the person to leave the Courtroom. The person can then take steps to make a change to the questionable garment or proceed to Court and be subject to possible instructions by the Presiding Judge.
